



Figure 3c – Synthesis of subject C-27's micro-phenomenological explicitation interview, phase of the aftermath

Figure 4a – Synthesis of subject C-30's micro-phenomenological explicitation interview, phase of the anticipation





Figure 4b – Synthesis of subject C-30's micro-phenomenological explicitation interview, phase of the crisis






Figure 4c – Synthesis of subject C-30's micro-phenomenological explicitation interview, phase of the aftermath




Figure 5a – Synthesis of subject D-05's micro-phenomenological explicitation interview, phase of the crisis




Figure 6a – Synthesis of subject D-07's micro-phenomenological explicitation interview, phase of the crisis
